 - CEP Goals Presentation
 - What are CEP Goals?
The Comprehensive Education Plan CEP 2023-2024 was shared with a presentation.
 - We have SMART goals, Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Relevant, Time-bound.
 - Math: students progress from grades 3-5 are measured using the NWEA Map screener.
 - ELA
 - Students' reading levels are measured using TCRWP running records. There are separate goals, one for all students, one for students with disabilities, one for English language learners.
 - Special Education:
 - There are 3 parts to it. These goals are not based on assessments, but on students' voice, parent's voice, and quality IEP CEP. An important part of the IEP is knowing how students learn best, and family feedback.
 - Attendance:
 - Students are allowed to miss 10% in the school year. In other words, 18 days. If a student misses more than that is considered chronic absenteeism. Attendance is crucial for students' learning. Robocalls are in place to inform families about absences on the day of the absence. For those
